Subject Precautionary Boil Water Notice

A precautionary boil water notice will be issued for your area served by the City of Lake Worth Beach Water Utilities potable water distribution system beginning on January 9, 2020 at 11:30 am.

Water will be off from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm

Reason for notice: 2" Water main break broken by contractor located at 401 4th Ave. South

Therefore, as a precaution, the Utility is advising that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient.

This notice affects 49 customers and includes the following addresses:

Where there is a loss of power and you are unable to boil water, disinfect water using household bleach. Add 6 drops of bleach to each gallon of water. Double the amount of bleach if the water is cloudy, colored, or very cold. Stir and let stand for 30 minutes.

This precautionary boil water notice will remain in effect until the problem has been corrected and a bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink.
